
Elk Grove FALLEN SOLDIER Memorial Scholarship

Overview:

This scholarship is based on the CHARACTER COUNTS!_{SM} pillar of **Citizenship.** It honors four young citizens of Elk Grove Village who paid the ultimate sacrifice for our nation in the wars that followed the September 11, 2001 attacks on our nation. The four soldiers are:

James S. Cronin Phillip E. Frank John T. Olson Adriana N. Salem

The Fallen Soldier Memorial Scholarship is presented by a partnership of the Village of Elk Grove, The Friends of the Elk Grove Library, and the Community Character Coalition of Elk Grove.

2017 Awards:

Four scholarships will be awarded. Each is a non-renewable \$1,000 scholarship to be used at a college or university, a junior college, or a trade or vocational school.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be Elk Grove Village residents.

Applicants must be **graduating high school seniors** beginning their college studies in the Fall Semester 2017. There are no restrictions regarding race, religion, national origin, gender or physical disability.

Requirements:

Applicants must submit a completed three-page application (attached) along with the following:

- √ Essay. (See Essay Guidelines on Page 3 of Application Form)
- √ One letter of reference from an employer or community member.
- V One letter of reference from a teacher, school counselor, coach or principal.
- √ Official High School Transcript.

Only complete applications with all required documentation will be considered.

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Evaluation Criteria:

In order of importance:

- 1) Service and leadership in the community;
- 2) Participation and leadership involvement in school activities;
- 3) Citizenship Essay; and
- 4) Academic achievement.

This is not an academic scholarship, nor is it a need-based scholarship. The primary evaluation criterion is Citizenship. The award committee will look at how applicants understand citizenship and how they have contributed to their school and community by displaying good citizenship.

Selection:

Selection will be made by the Scholarship Committee of the Community Character Coalition of Elk Grove.

Deadline:

3:00 pm on Thursday, April 13, 2017

Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.
